II. **Summary:** The Ohio Hazmat TAC met at Ohio EMA and via phone conference to finalize regional capabilities and look at completion of type I build out across the state. TAC chair Greg Locher the committee through the update process with regions reporting the following:

Regional build out of Type II and I teams

Region I – \$100,000

- Type II - build out complete
- Type I - build out \$100,000 for Allen County to complete team. Toledo will complete Type I team with UASI funding.

Region II - \$0

- Type II – build out complete
- Type I – Lake and Cuyahoga County combined team complete

Region III - \$71,000

- Type II – Clark County completion \$14,000
- Type I – Dayton Regional \$57,000

Region IV - \$90,000

- Type II – 12 teams for completion \$40,000
- Type I – Columbus Fire \$50,000

Region V - \$151,000

- Type II – Richland/Ashland combined \$51,000
- Type I – Akron/Summit combined \$100,000. Looking for \$50,000 from CEDAP.

Region VI - \$35,000

- Type II – completed using UASI funding for 4 teams in Hamilton County
- Type I – Cincinnati Fire \$35,000 to complete. Will leverage \$15,000 2009 UASI funds. Greater Cincinnati will complete Type I with no funding request from TAC

Region VII - \$12,000

- Type II – \$12,000 for Hocking and Lawrence to complete teams
- Type I - \$0 No type I being considered within region

Region VIII - \$0

- Type II – Leverage \$3,000 from 2008 TAC funding to complete build out
- Type I - \$0 No type I being considered within region

Determining Factors for Team Consideration

- Is team response able?

- Is team willing to respond regionally?
- Can team be self sustaining after build out completed?
- How close is team \$\$ to completion?

III. **Action Items:** will be discussed at the next meeting:

- Gap Analysis. What areas of state have been missed and how will they be covered.
- Greg Locher – discuss with Mel left over funds from last grant cycle and the ability to transfer those funds to another region for build out completion.
- 52 WMD to give presentation at October meeting – capabilities
- Type IV teams on Ohio Fire Response Database to be cleaned up with Hazmat Regional Coordinators working with Ohio Fire Chiefs Regional Coordinators (carried over from August)
- Greg Locher – Target Capability Update (new guidelines due out October 2008)
- NIMSCAST completion of Jurisdictions – Regional Coordinators
- Mel House – Letter to Allen County for Type II team recognition
- Mel House – Grant Update
- Committee – Creation of flow chart for dispatchers with questions relating to type of team being requested.
